



Calcium Hypochlorite

BRIQUETTES

FIRST AID: IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. **Do not** induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. **Do not** give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

PRIMEROS AUXILIOS: SI ENTRA EN CONTACTO CON LOS OJOS: Mantenga el ojo abierto y enjuáguelo lenta y suavemente con agua durante 15 a 20 minutos. Quítese los lentes de contacto, si hubiere, después de los primeros 5 minutos, luego siga enjuagándose el ojo. Llame a un centro de control de envenenamiento o a un médico para recibir consejos médicos sobre el tratamiento. **SI TOCA LA PIEL O LA ROPA:** Quiétese la ropa contaminada. Enjuáguese la piel de inmediato con agua abundante durante 15 a 20 minutos. Llame a un centro de control del envenenamiento o al médico para consejos sobre el tratamiento. **SI SE INGIERE:** Llame inmediatamente a un centro de control de envenenamiento o a un médico para recibir consejos médicos sobre el tratamiento. Haga que la persona tome sorbitos de un vaso de agua si puede tragar. **No** induzca el vómito a menos que en el centro de control de envenenamiento o un médico se lo indique. **No** introduzca nada por la boca de una persona inconsciente. **SI SE INHALA:** Traslade a la persona al aire fresco. Si la persona no respira, llame al 911 o a una ambulancia, luego administre respiración artificial, preferiblemente de boca a boca si es posible. Llame a un centro de control de envenenamiento o a un médico para consejos sobre tratamiento adicional. Tenga a la mano el envase o la etiqueta del producto cuando llame al centro de control de envenenamiento o al médico o cuando acuda para el tratamiento. **NOTA AL MÉDICO:** Los probables daños a la mucosa podrían contraindicar el uso de lavado gástrico.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep this product dry in its tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Keep away from heat or open flame. **DO NOT** reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material and discard container in trash. **DO NOT** contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal or cleaning of equipment. For disposal of a contaminated or decomposing product, see EMERGENCY HANDLING.

DO NOT** touch this chemical with a flame or burning material (like a lighted cigarette).
